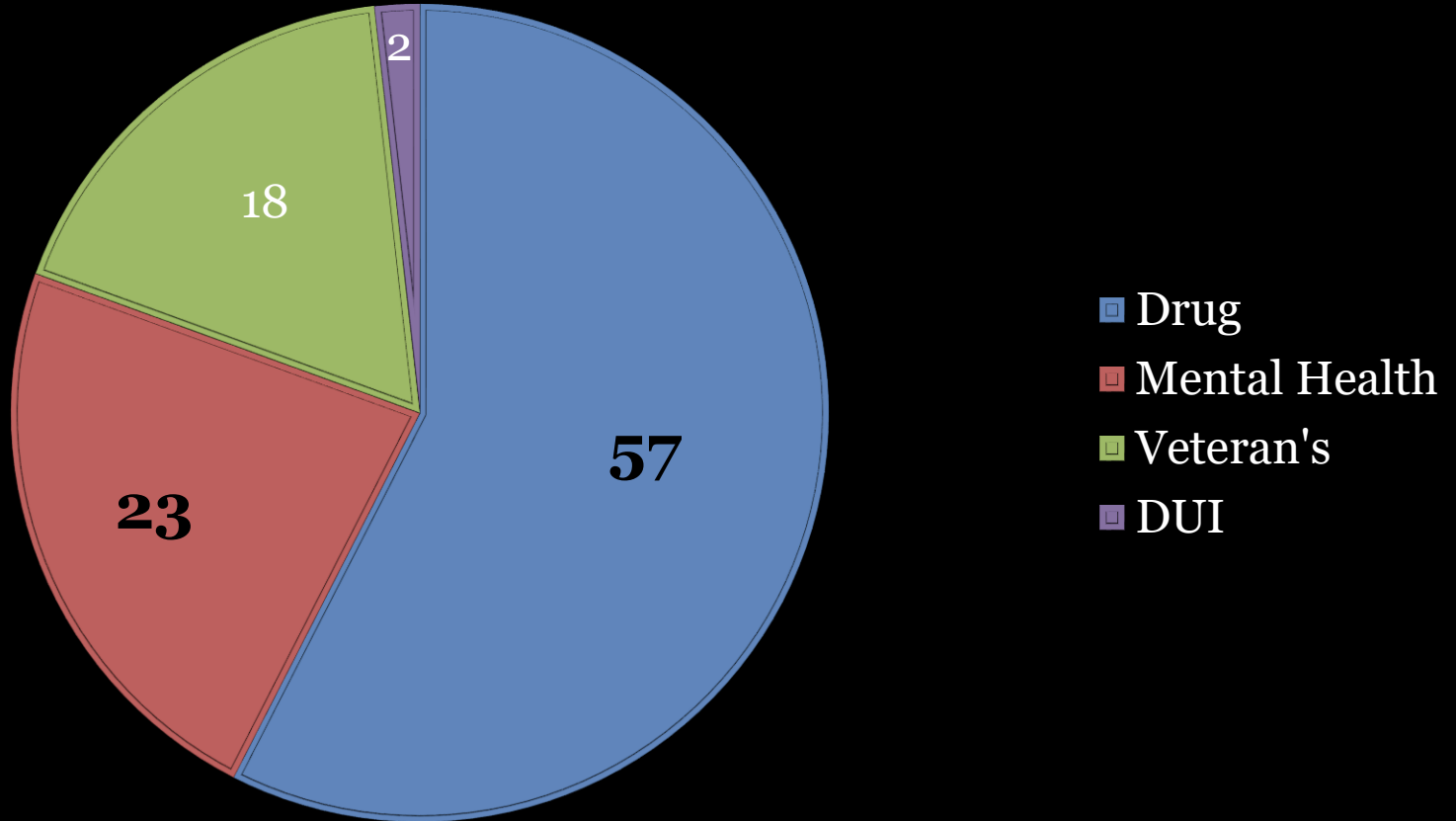

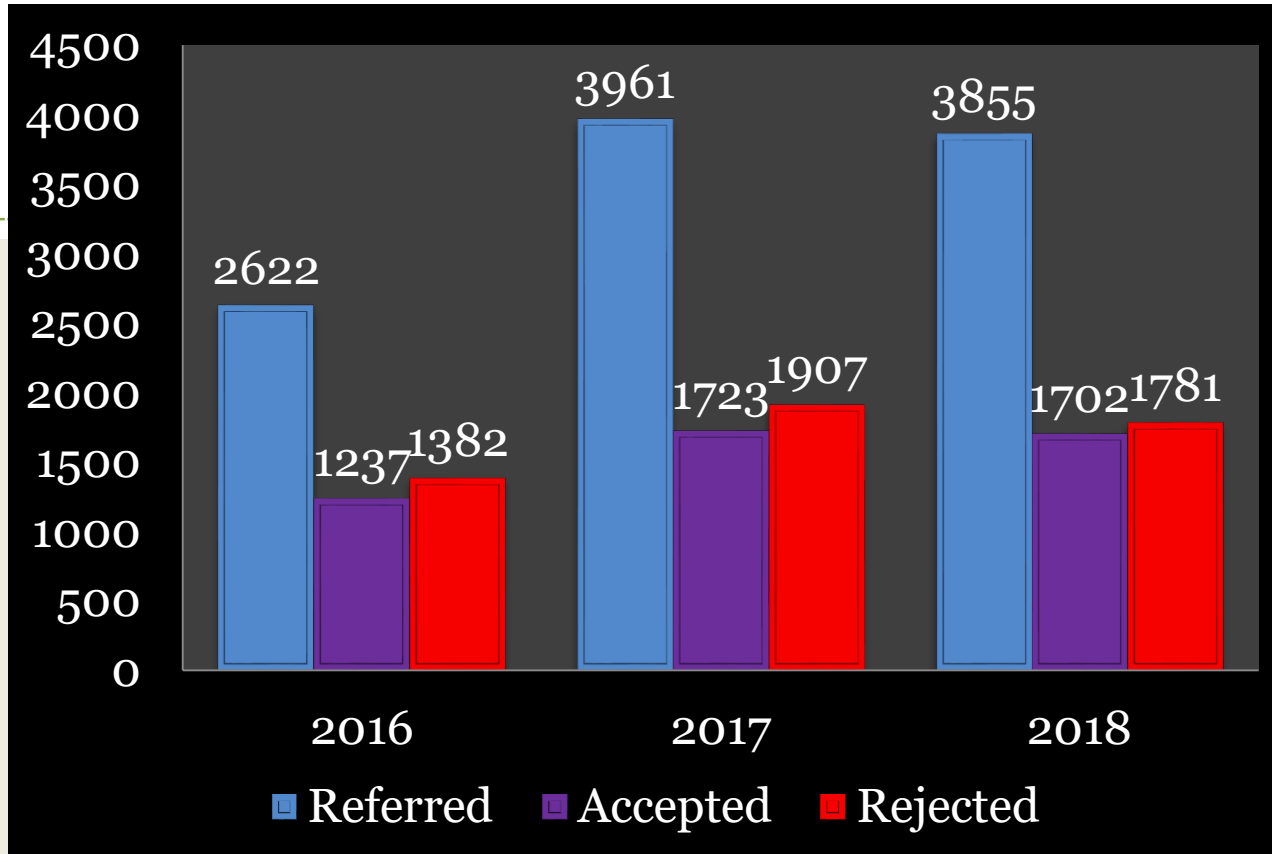


•113 Total PSC in Illinois

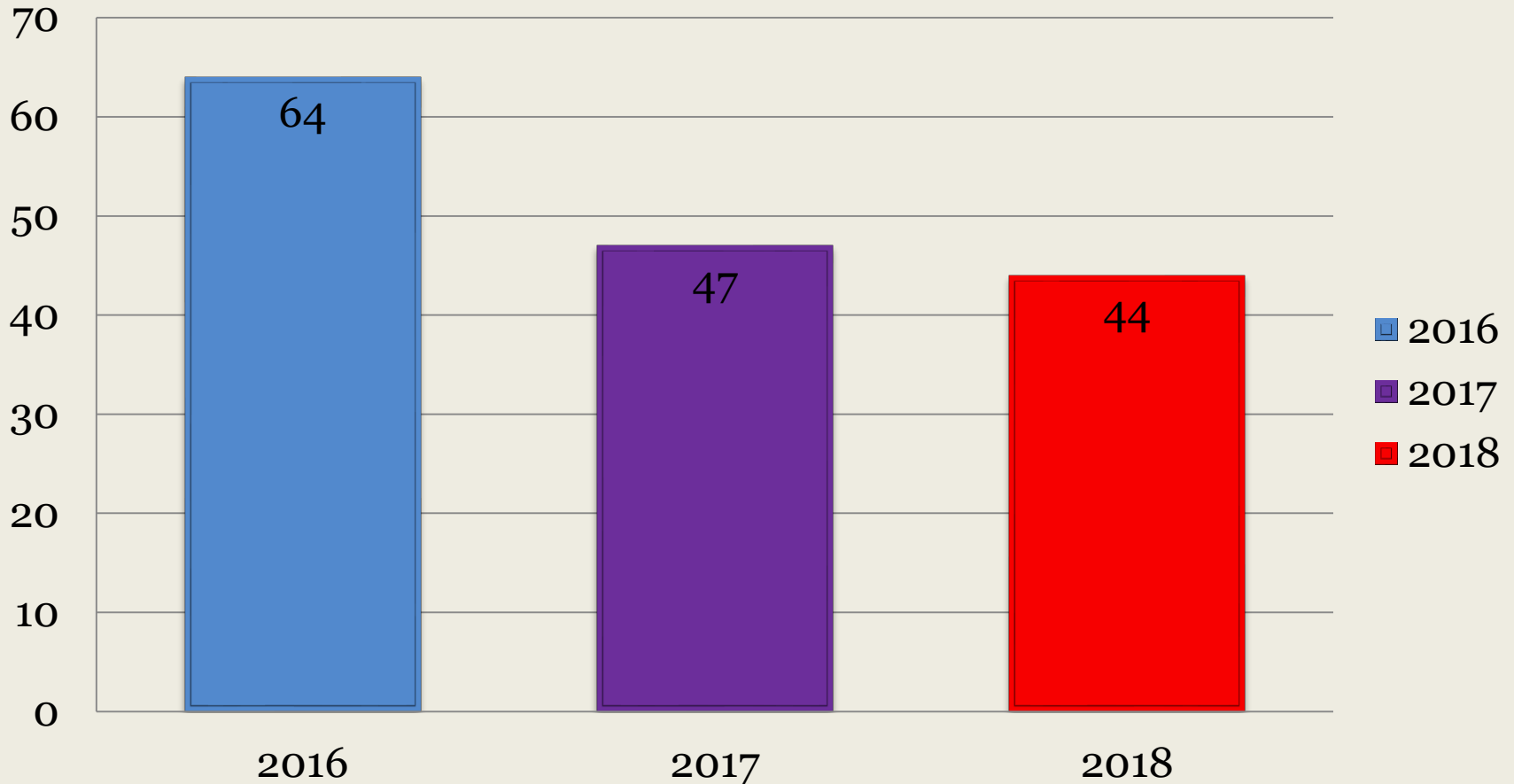

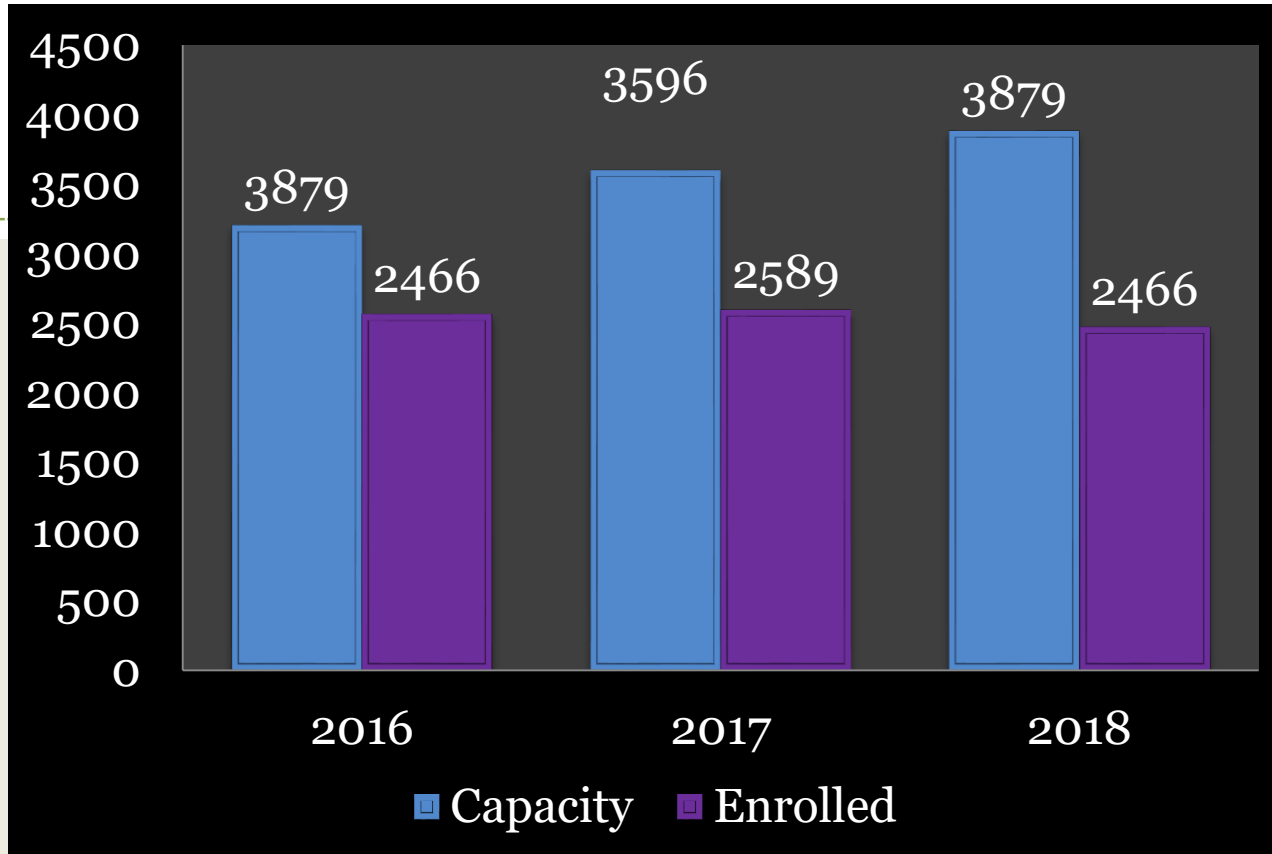

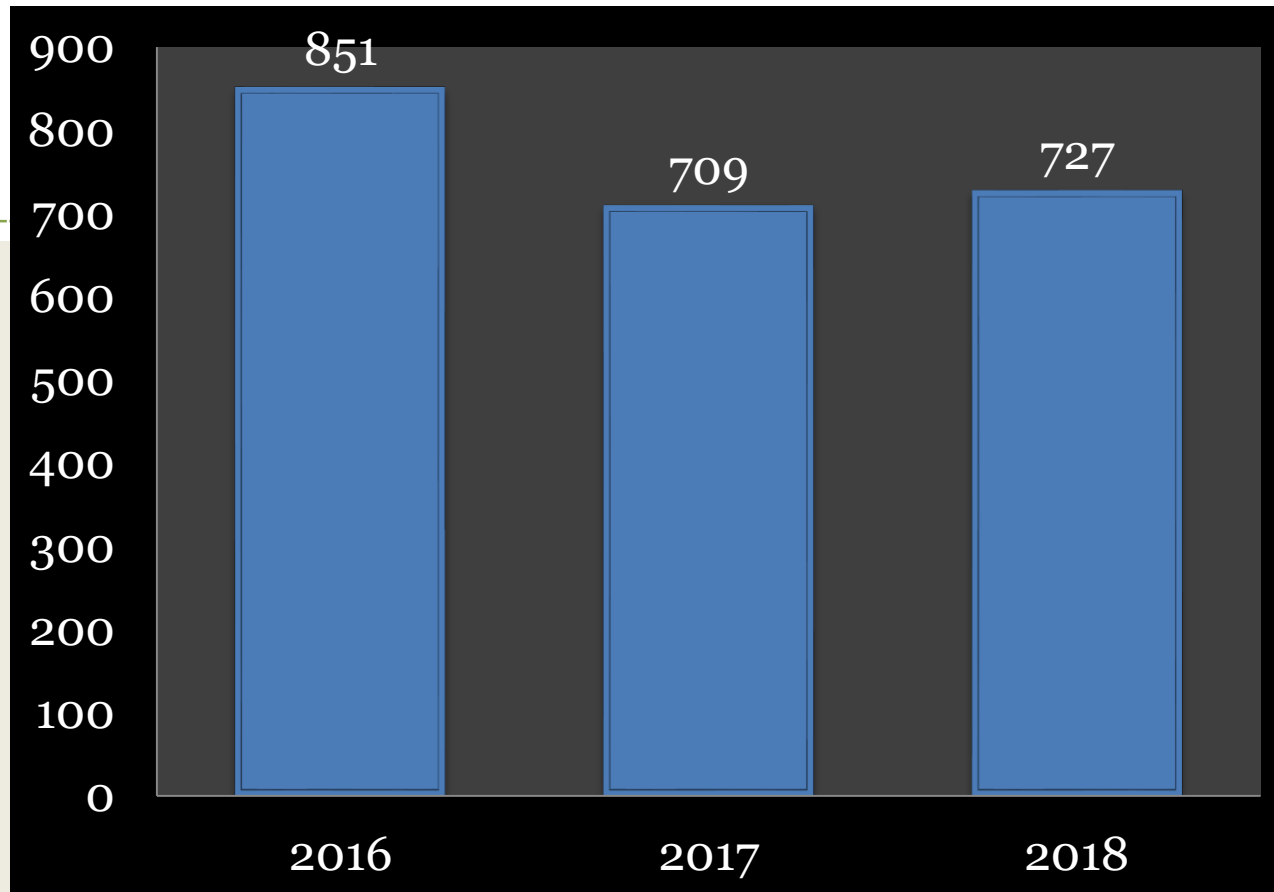
