













Gambling in Illinois What other recent development do you think is important?











Symptoms • needing to increase amounts gambled • restless or irritable* when cutting down/quitting • repeated unsuccessful attempts to control/cut back/quit • often preoccupied with gambling • gambles when distressed DSM-5-American Psychiatric Association



Similarities & Differences Are we talking about substance use disorders or gambling disorder? You be the judge: SUD or GD? • Genetic heretibility • early exposure increases risk • train reward center activation • impairment in judgment/future planning areas of the brain • trauma history increases risk for development of the disorder • accessibility and acceptability affect use • follows a predictable path • responds to CBT, MI, DBT, and medications
